

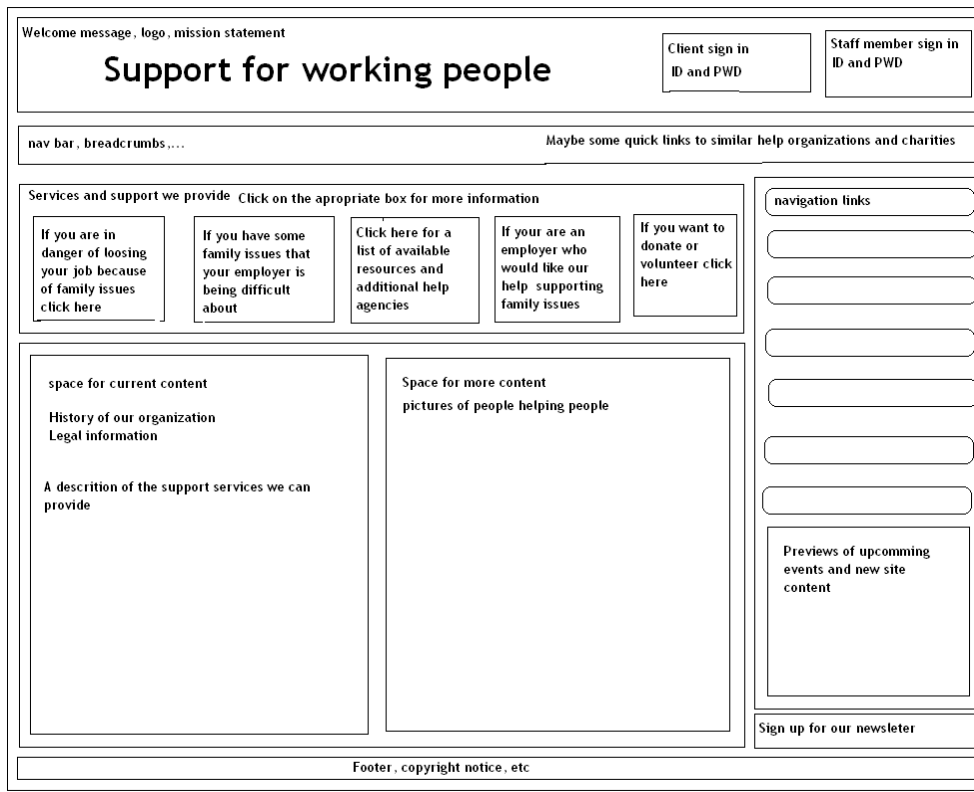

This organization needs a website that is warm and welcoming. It will serve as the first point of contact with most clients and must explain the mission of the group and provide a quick connection to the help the group has to offer. The home page proposal here has these properties. The top section will include the organization's short mission statement and the all-important links to the primary services pages will be prominently positioned just under the headings.

Secondary pages will carry the same color scheme and basic layout so the visitor feels continuity on the site. Returning registered visitors will have a sign-in form at the top right that will take them to the services page preloaded with their data and recent history. There is also a staff login that will allow staff and volunteers access to the secure staff functions pages. There will be a security measures statement connected with both of these secure login forms. This statement will pop up for a few seconds as logins are processed.

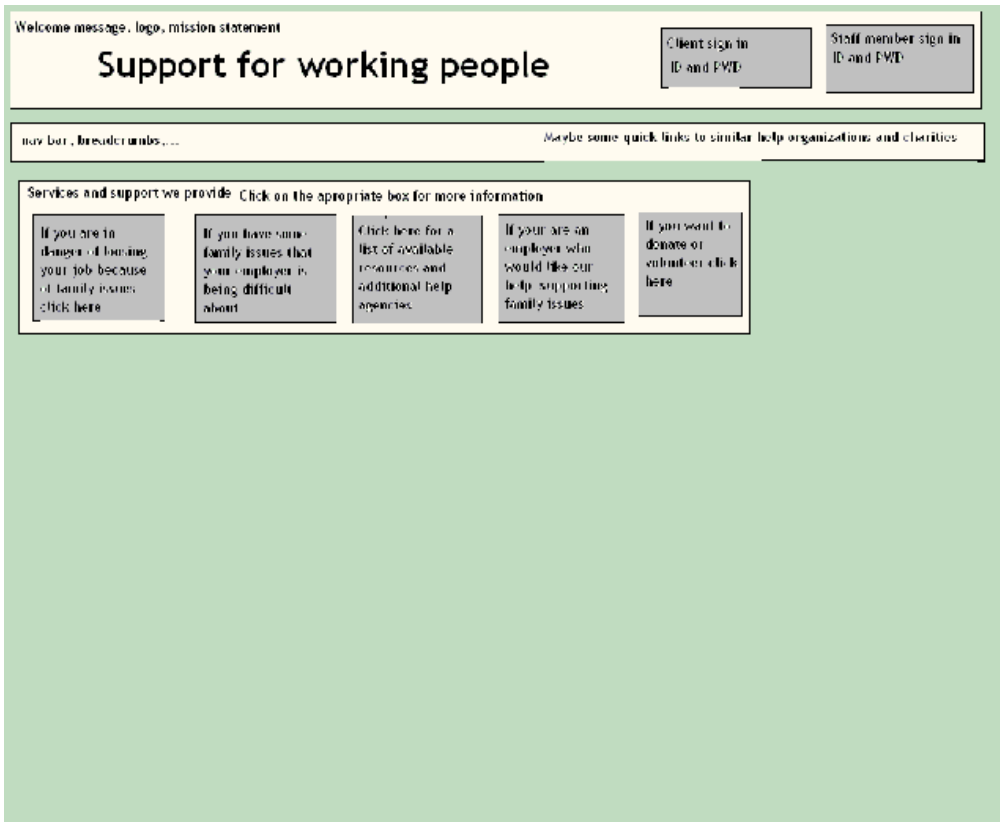

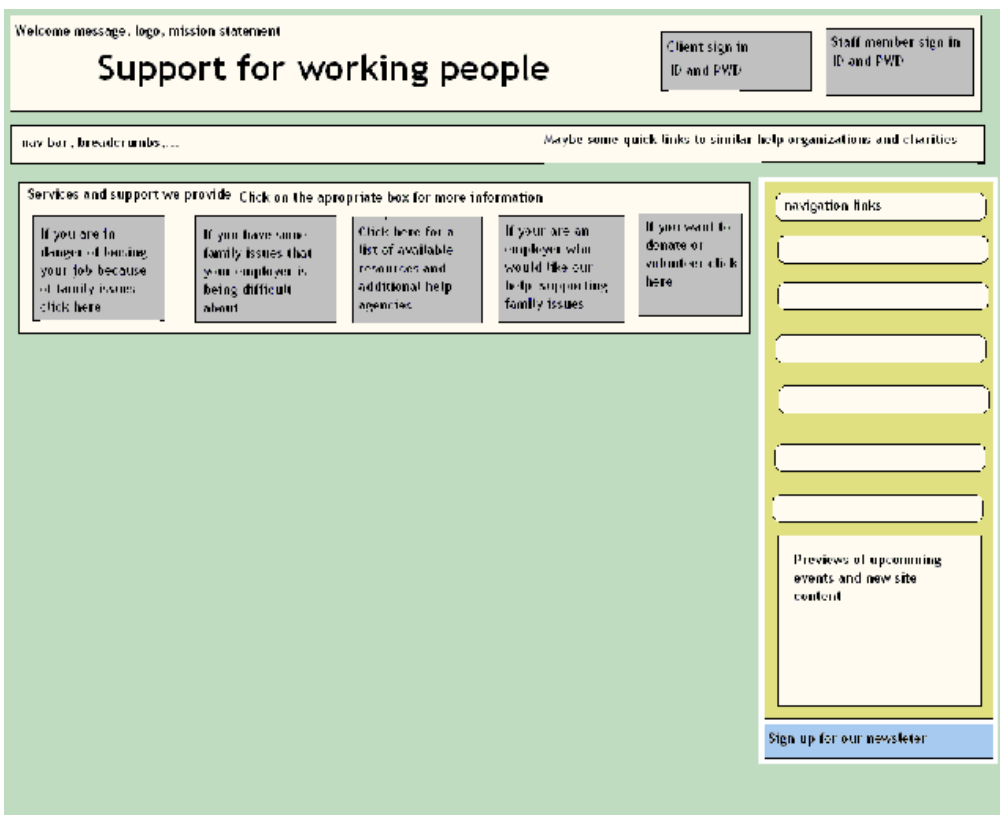
This is a proposed layout for the home page of the new site. The text and shapes are just for demonstration purposes and will receive significant styling and formatting before the release.



This is a simplified demonstration of a proposed color scheme for the top section of the home page. The color scheme eventually agreed upon will be applied to the entire site to promote a sense of continuity between the pages.



The blocks in the second section will be reconfigured as styled buttons linked to these important related pages. This group of links will be the most important and most used links on the home page. The actual labels for the buttons will be determined as the pages for the links are selected.



The right side bar will contain links to secondary pages on the site. These buttons too will be styled and labeled appropriately. This navigation bar will be included on most of the pages of the site. One link

will be to a site map and another will be to a help screen for the site. The empty space to the left is reserved for content. Note: the second section with the primary link buttons will be on the home page only.
